Thumb Box Exhibition

December 2013 at the Ohio Art League Gallery

November 14, 2013 – COLUMBUS, OHIO – During the month of December, the Ohio Art League hosts its annual Thumb Box Exhibition of small works in the OAL Gallery at South Campus Gateway. For this intriguing show, member artists submit 2D or 3D works which can measure no more than 6”x6”x6” in dimension.

With a long and storied tradition, the first exhibition of this type was held in 1916 and continued annually during the early part of the League’s history. After a hiatus, Thumb Box returned in 2006 and now continues into 2013.

Thumb Box runs December 5–28, 2013 in the OAL Gallery in South Campus Gateway, 1552 N. High St. Columbus, OH 43201. The gallery is free and open to the public: Monday through Wednesday 12:00–6:00 p.m. and Thursday through Saturday 12:00–8:00 p.m.
